



Community Education Opportunities

KDPS provides free training to community groups, businesses, and organizations.



Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events (CRASE): This 2-hour training course provides strategies, guidance, and plans aimed to help civilians survive an active shooter event.

Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR): This 4-hour training provides the information and skills needed to help adults, children, and infants during cardiac emergencies.



Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED): This individualized assessment provides input on using design and environment elements to create defensible spaces to reduce victimization and deter criminal acts.

Car Seat Installation: This individualized service connects you with a child passenger safety technician who will make sure your child's car seat is installed correctly and will teach you how to use and install a car seat on your own.
